Welcome to Storybook Theatre Camp! Our ten day program will have students exploring their creativity and imagination, utilizing stage performance techniques taught by industry professionals. Some of the areas we will be concentrating on are: warm ups, voice, movement, storytelling, improvisation and collaboration. Students learn to Act, Sing and Dance from a team of coaches, each with their area of expertise. Curriculum has been developed to provide a safe, fun and supportive environment to help participants grow in confidence and learn many valuable skills that transfer to everyday life. The aim is to encourage the development of artistic instincts in children, which has been proven to provide many benefits later in life.

Location

All classes take place at the **Community Arts Centre at 2633 Hochwald Ave S.W. in the Currie Barracks**. We are located upstairs. Throughout the camp we be learning in our three rehearsal studios, and have the opportunity to present our work on stage in the Easterbrook Theatre, our 150 seat performance space, complete with lights, sound and stage, to provide the full theatrical experience! Friends and family are welcome to join us for the gala performance at the end of each camp!

Structure

Classes run for 10 days (Monday - Friday in the summer and Saturdays in the fall/winter/spring sessions). Start times vary with age groups and can be found, along with other details such as cost and instructor resume's, in the theatre school section of our website at www.storybooktheatre.org. Although we strive to maintain specific age groupings, we sometimes need to combine groups to create full classes. When this is necessary, we ensure the material taught is suitable for the whole class.

Each class will start with a warm up, after which students will spend their time learning acting exercises and games, singing, dancing, making props and/or costumes and creating what will be the final show. The theme of each camp is different, taking into account the specific makeup of the participants, and drawing material from popular plays and musicals, which are family friendly and fun! Class will end each day with a cool down and wrap up. Parents are not invited to observe class as it can inhibit the students, but are welcome to join us for our final performance!
